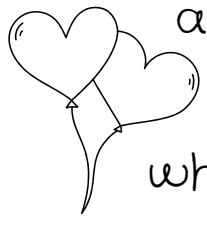

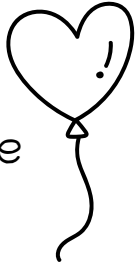

THE BEGINNING OF MASS: THE INTRODUCTORY RITE & THE PENITENTIAL RITE



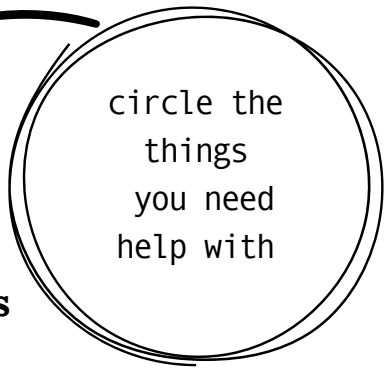

THE MIDDLE OF MASS: THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

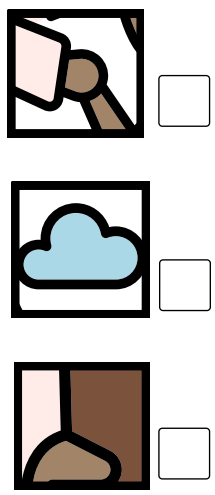
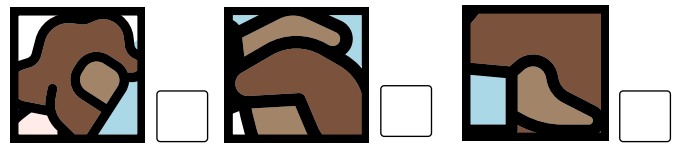

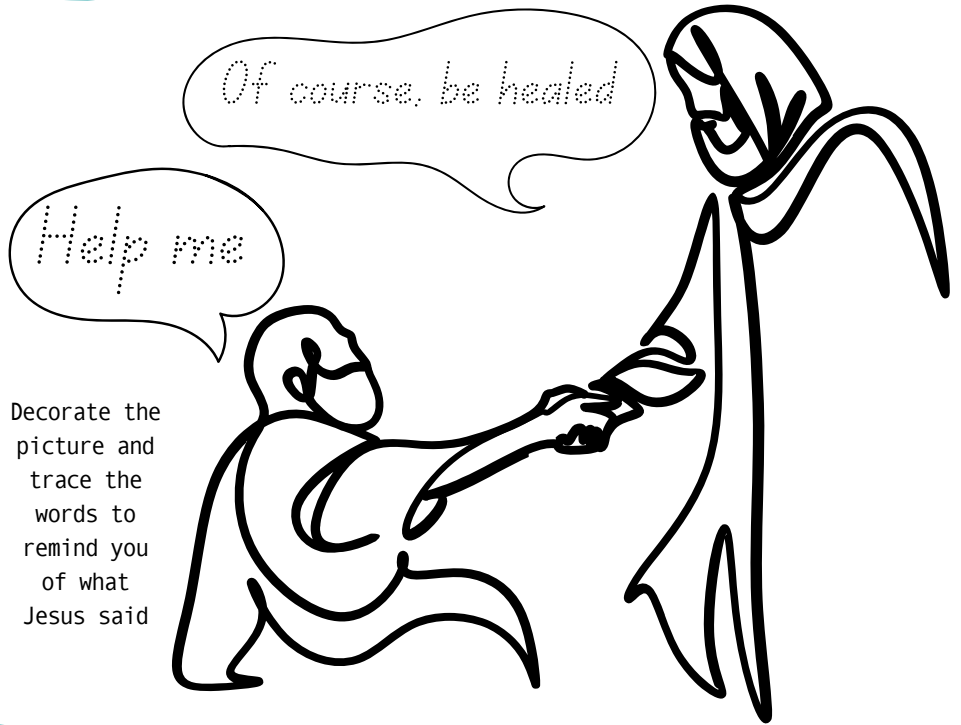
PARTS OF THE MASS: THE GLORIA

The beginning of Lent

This week coming we begin Lent, the time before Easter where we might give things up, spend more time praying. It is a time to get ready for Easter. Like Jesus did for 40 days in the desert.

Tuesday: Celebrate shrove Tuesday (pancake day)

Ash Wednesday - burying the Alleluia

You will need:

Paper, pens, and a box

What to do:

During Lent, we give up singing Alleluia. To show that this is a more serious time.

This week, write out the word Alleluia, decorate it, colour it in and then put it in a box, hide it or bury it in the garden. Then at Easter you can dig it up or bring it back out when we celebrate Jesus rising from the dead!
